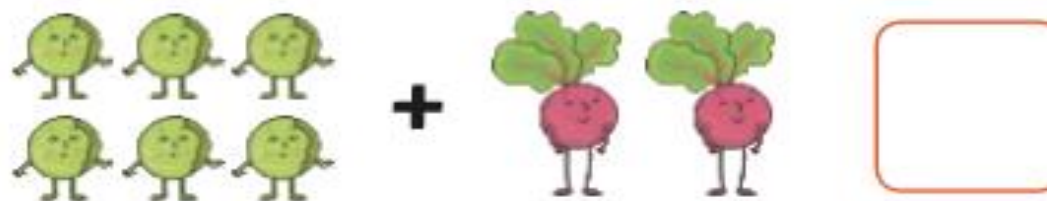
Pizza Shape Colouring








