Please continue to check Class Dojo for Nursery messages. If you have not done so please upload photos of your child's home learning. Thank you to parents who have already started to do this.

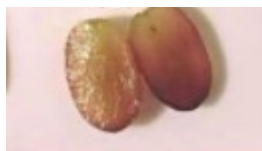


Safeguarding

When collecting your child at the end of their session, we would like to remind you to stand well away from the Nursery door to enable us to safely dismiss the children. The nursery staff need to keep our children safe and crowding by the door makes this difficult to do and can also be distressing for the children.

Donations.

We kindly ask for a voluntary contribution of a £1 a week (£6 for half term). Your donation enables us to plan for and prepare exciting activities for your child. Donations are made online using the Weduc App.



Grapes

If your child has grapes for snack please make sure these are sliced lengthways to avoid a choking hazard, in line with health and safety guidance.

Chewing Gum

Please make sure your child does not arrive at Nursery with chewing gum.



Rest

Some children are arriving at Nursery very sleepy. Please ensure your child comes to school following a good night of sleep. NHS guidance states children 3 to 5 years need 10-13 hours of sleep including naps.

Supporting independence

Please encourage your child to become more independent by showing them how to put on their coat or jumper without help and also manage their own toileting needs.

STRICT Nursery Uniform

School uniform for Nursery children consists of a grey sweatshirt and grey jogging bottoms.

Please ensure your child comes to Nursery wearing the appropriate uniform with their name written on all items.
