We are currently recruiting highly skilled TAs to support and lead interventions, for SEN pupils in early years and / or Key Stage 1, who can also offer 1:1 support to an SEN learner with moderate or severe needs. We require an **experienced individual** with the ability to speak one of the following community languages is desirable – Romanian, Gujarati, Arabic, Farsi, Persian or Dari. The applicant **must** also possess a relevant **Level 3 qualification** which is an essential requirement, **graduate level qualifications would also be desirable**. Their main role will be to work as part of a team, provide one-to-one and small group support both in and out of the classroom and be able to demonstrate impact on pupil progress. This is in addition to promoting inclusion and promoting positive behaviour.

- **Duties will include:**

- Working with the Inclusion Leader to plan and deliver intervention and support to targeted pupil/s.

- Keeping records up to date and ensuring that other members of staff and parents/carers where applicable are informed of pupil progress and needs.
- Ensuring that the children in the class are safe at all times.
- Promoting inclusion and encouraging the pupil to develop social, emotional and language skills at their own pace.
- Following all school policies and procedures.

Applicants with at least a minimum of 6 months' recent work experience as a Teaching Assistant within a Primary School setting desirable. **Excellent verbal and written literacy skills.**

Previous experience and knowledge of the EYFS/KS 1 curriculum and **phonics is absolutely essential** and candidates will be expected to show a high level of understanding and practice. Examples of this must be provided at interview.
