The funding is being used for a range of provisions:

- Specialist PE coach to work with KS 1 teachers, team teaching and providing ongoing CPD.
- CPD and ongoing support for the PE lead.
- Encourage pupil engagement in physical activity throughout the school day.
- Encourage more children to be involved in intra-sporting events and sporting events related to the wider community.
- Engage in sporting activities with other schools.
- Subsidise ASC which support physical development.
