Literacy

- Phase 2 phonemes and tricky words.
- Hearing and writing initial/medial/final sounds in words.
- Writing a simple sentence.
- Reading books in line phonic knowledge.
- Identify features of non-fiction texts.
- Retell stories in their own words using newly learnt vocabulary.
- Learn Poems

<u>Key Texts:</u> Polar Bear Polar Bear what do you hear? Lost and found, The Diwali story, The Christmas story, Poles apart and non-fiction texts.

Communication and Language

- Listening to and retelling a story.
- Learn the names of everyday objects at school.
- Be able to speak in full sentences, moving away from single word answers.
