### Planned expenditure

The funding the year will be used for a range of provisions including the following:

- Specialist PE teacher to work with KS 1 staff, team teaching and providing ongoing CPD.
- CPD and ongoing support for the PE lead.
- Look to increase parental engagement in physical activity with their children.
- Encourage pupil engagement in physical activity throughout the school day both at school and beyond in the community.
- Encourage more children to be involved in intra-sporting events and sporting events related to the wider community.
- Engage in sporting activities with other schools and across all groups of learners (SEN and disadvantaged).
- Subsidise ASC which support physical development.
