Homework

Please also go through the vocabulary list with your child over the weekend and talk about the meaning of the words. This will support them with learning in the classroom.

Homework is compulsory so please support your child to complete it every week.



Please remember to send a healthy snack (fruits or vegetables only) and a bottle of water daily for your child. No nuts are allowed on site as

we are a NUT FREE school. Remember to make sure their snack boxes, bottles, bags, jumpers and coats are clearly labelled with their names.

Reception Uniform

Please ensure that children are wearing the correct uniform for Reception i.e. black or grey trousers for boys a white T- shirt gramme supporting early and a school jumper/cardigan. The uniform for girls is grey or black skirt/pinafore/trousers white T-shirt ,school jumper/ cardigan and grey/black tights if needed. They all need to wear black school shoes without laces. Please avoid boots.

From 02.09.23 children will be starting school full time and the timings are-

8.40 am—3.15 pm

Please be punctual otherwise children miss crucial learning and you could be issued with a penalty Notice.

Hot School Meals At School

Please remember to look at the lunch menu every day and talk to your child about the different food options that they will be able to choose from.

Help your child to become as independent as possible and encourage them to feed themselves using a fork or spoon. You may also like to cook some of the different foods on our menu at home, so that your child develops their palette and become familiar with the meals that will be served at school. Thank you
