Sorting issues

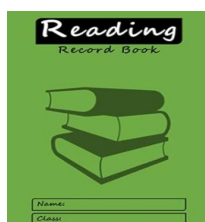
We would like to request that you notify the class teacher if your child has been hurt by another child. Please do not approach other parents to complain about their child as they too may not be aware. The class teacher may have already sorted the issue and if not then they will resolve it and also inform the parents. Please trust the school to deal with incidences that happen during the school day.

We want to avoid unnecessary animosity between our parent community.

Reading books

Before the half term break we will start sending reading books home. Some children will receive pictures-only books, others will have books with words. Please read and talk with our child every

day for 5-10 minutes with their book. Talk about the pictures, read the title, sound out the letters (phonemes) and blend them into words. The children need to read the book fluently by the time they return it back to school. Before sending it home, the children will have practised reading the book at school. Please write a short comment at home about your child's reading in the green reading record book.



Class timings:

All Reception Classes start at: **8.40am and finish at 3.15pm.** The gates open at 8.30 so please make sure your child is in the classroom by 8.40 am.

PE at School

We ask you to send your child's PE kit to school, packed in the school green PE bag: black shorts or grey tracksuit bottoms, white t-shirt, plimsolls or trainers. After the half term break we will be starting our PE lessons. We want the children to start practising changing into their PE kits at school. Please help your child become independent in dressing/undressing, and putting on/taking off their socks/shoes.

These are important child development skills which form part of the early years framework and assessment.

On your child's PE day, please avoid putting tights on your child as they struggle to put them on.
