In order to achieve the Health and Self Care Early Learning Goal, children need to be able to do the following without any adult support:

Take off and put on jumpers.

Fasten and unfasten buttons on cardigans and shirts.

Put on trousers and fasten any zips.

Put on socks and tights. Put shoes on the right feet.

Recognise when clothes are inside out or back to front and know how to turn their clothes the right way round.

It is important for parents to help their child to develop these basic self care skills and to encourage their child to become as independent as possible. Please support your child during the holiday to achieve this target.
