of NOT using pushchairs and buggies when collecting Nursery children. It is incredibly important for their physical development as well as social interaction. For example, eye contact, singing and talking. This DOES NOT happen if your child is in a pushchair. Walking with your child does take more time and this needs to be planned into your day but the benefits of walking together are immense.
