## Walking to school

I would also like to remind parents about the importance of **NOT** transporting the nursery child in a pushchair or buggy when collecting or dropping off to Nursery. It is incredibly important for their physical development to be physically mobile in addition to their social interaction. For example, eye contact, singing and talking. This **DOES NOT** happen if your child is in a pushchair. Walking with your child does take more time and this needs to be planned into your day but the benefits of walking together are immense.

## Learning Dispositions

At our school we aim to equip our children with the skills necessary to become independent and effective learners. We promote positive learning dispositions by talking about four characters, some of which you may be familiar with.

### Team Ant
