### Promoting healthy eating.

Please remember to send a healthy **snack (fruits or vegetables only) and a bottle of water** daily for your child.

**Grapes:** If your child brings grapes as a snack please make sure these are sliced lengthways to avoid a choking hazard.

### School uniform

**Children need to come to school dressed in their school uniform every day which comprises of black/grey school trousers/skirt/pinafore, grey school sweat-shirt /cardigan with school logo on, polo shirt underneath, black school shoes with Velcro.**
